

Whānau Say:

We notice and write down new things pēpi is doing.

We get excited when pēpi tries to interact with us.

Pēpi lets us know by the cues when they have had had enough.

Baby's learning to 'multi task' using information from senses all at once, e.g. reach, poke, mouth, grab, listen and look.

We share small chunky books with hard pages and brightly coloured pictures. Adding lots of sounds or making up stories helps to keep pēpi interested.
