

Whānau Say:

We see them using 'trial and error' to solve simple problems. If something doesn't work, they'll try another way.

We try and make playing together a regular part of every day.

We need to make sure that when we've had a bad day, that we don't show it around them.

We have noticed although pēpi enjoys being around other tamariki, and still has lots to learn about how to interact, play and communicate with them.

We have started introducing words like 'tohatoha'—share.

Pēpi is still learning about sharing or having turns—they think if they give things away they won't come back!
